As we begin a new academic term, I wanted to take a moment to update you all on our school attendance statistics after term 1.

- Ducklings= 95.8%
- Rabbits= 96.6%
- Badgers= 97.9%
- Foxes= 98.1%
- Lions= 97.5%
- Eagles= 98.8%

Whole school = 97.5%

We understand that there can be challenges to ensuring your child attends school regularly. Our attendance aspiration is 100% for this academic year but we recognise that children will miss school due to illness or other events in their lives. Our minimum expectation for 2024/25 is 96%, which allows for approximately 7 days of absence due to illness. We are currently on track to achieve our target! Thank you for your support with attendance so far this year. As winter approaches, we understand that attendance can sometimes go down.
