The use of ICT has become an important part of learning within our school. Alongside teaching how to use these technologies, we teach the underlying principles of how to stay safe online. We also teach children what they need to do if something online isn't right and proper.

I will be a SMART user of IT because:

- I will keep my passwords secret.
- I will only use the computer for things my teacher has told me to.
- I will make sure that any messages I send are polite.
- I will tell a teacher or parent if I see something that makes me feel scared or uncomfortable on the screen.
- I will not reply to any nasty message or anything that makes me feel uncomfortable.
- I will not tell people about myself online (I will not tell them my name, anything about my home, family, pets and school).
- In school, I will only use my school email.
- I will only email people I know or who my teacher or parent says it is okay to email.
- I will never agree to meet a stranger.
- I will not put photographs of myself online without asking a teacher or parent.
- I know that my teacher or parent can check what I do online and that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use a computer.
