Field to Food - Year 5/6 Trip Wednesday 23rd April

Dear Parents and Carers

Our Year 5s and 6s have been invited to attend the annual Field to Food Learning Day at the Bath & West Showground on Wednesday 23rd April 2025. This is only available to a handful of schools and we are extremely lucky to be offered the opportunity to attend.

The Field to Food Learning Day is all about educating the next generation about farming and food production.

Your child will need:

- A water bottle
- A packed lunch & healthy snack. If you would like the school to provide your child packed lunch, please email the office by the 1st April.
- Waterproof coat,
- School uniform - children can wear leggings and trainers.

For this trip, we will be asking for a contribution of **£5.50 to cover the cost of travel**. Please pay and consent to your child participating in the trip via ParentPay by **Friday 28th February 2025**.

If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium we ask for a contribution of £4.40 please edit the amount to pay via parentpay, we can then use your pupil premium allowance to 'top up'.

As you will be aware, school finances across the country are an issue; therefore, if we do not receive a 95% total fee we unfortunately will not be able to allow the trip to go ahead.

If we do not reach the 95% target, we will ask families, if they wish, to make a donation to 'top up' funds. Please do not feel pressure to do this, only do it if you can; we have had many families ask if they can be given this choice before a trip is canceled.

We will confirm by Monday 3rd March if the trip is not able to go ahead.
