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## **News from the Classrooms**



This week, we have been carrying on the theme of Winter. We have been reading the story *One Snowy Night*. We have been re-enacting the story in the role play area being Percy and all the animals.





This week we learned about toys from the past and explored which materials they were made of. The year one children completed their maths unit "Addition and subtraction to 20", the reception children learned how to compare capacity and mass.



We also had lots of fun playing outdoors on Friday afternoon.



Starling Class have been really enjoying their unit on clay. They have learnt the skills of pinching to make a pot and how they can use 'slip' to join pieces together. We are really looking forward to our finished project but I am not going to give anything away - I will put some photos on here for you all to see!





This week, Goldfinch class have been learning to greet each other in French. They translated greetings from English to French, then with a partner created a script to read aloud to the class. We have practiced pronunciation and speaking clearly.
