Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to follow up with details of the forthcoming residential trip for Year 6 children (current Year 5s) next academic year.

Thankyou for paying the £50 deposit to secure your child's space. We can now confirm that the total cost for the trip as we expected will be £452.20. This includes travel, accommodation, food and activities.

The trip will take place from 8th – 12th September 2025 at the Osmington Bay PGL Activity Centre, near Weymouth.

Children will arrive at normal school time on Monday morning, with their luggage, and assemble in the school hall, where parents will be able to give medical forms along with any required medication to our staff. We will be leaving school at 9.30am and spend a few hours on Weymouth beach, or Nothe Fort, if the weather is inclement, from where we will travel to Osmington Bay Activity Centre. We will leave the centre at 1.30pm on Friday and should arrive back at school at around 3.00pm.

A payment has now been set up on parent pay for £402.20, you can pay in as many instalments as you wish however please ensure that there is a minimum of £160 by 2nd March 2025 and that the total is paid by 3rd July 2025. All payments may be made by ParentPay. Failure to make the full payment by the 3rd July will result in your child not being able to attend the camp, unfortunately the school does not have the finances to be able to pay. If you have any remaining credit on your parentpay account from the cancelled Westonbirt trip the money will be transferred across by the end of this week.

Children will need to bring a sleeping bag, pillow and pillowcase, please also see the attached kit list. We will also be sending a letter asking for details of allergies, dietary needs and photo permissions in July- Please ensure these are returned asap.

We very much hope that all next Year's Y6 children will be able to attend as a residential trip at PGL will provide experiences and memories that they will treasure.
