

BUCKLER'S MEAD ACADEMY PHYSICAL EDUCATION KIT

A high standard of dress for physical lessons is expected. Parents are asked to make sure the correct kit is worn by their children at all times. Their co-operation is anticipated.



Each student requires the following:

BOYS - Compulsory Items:

- Logoed Purple Polo Shirt
- Black Reversible BMA Rugby Shirt
- Plain Black Shorts
- Plain Black Football Socks
- Football Boots (**Moulded studs ONLY for Hockey/Football/Rugby**)
- Astro Turf Trainers/Trainers (No School Shoes/No Daps)



GIRLS - Compulsory Items:

- Logoed Purple Polo Shirt
- Black Logoed PE Sweatshirt OR Black Reversible BMA Rugby Shirt
- Plain Black Shorts OR Skort
- Plain Black Football Socks
- Football Boots (**Moulded studs ONLY for Hockey/Football/Rugby**)
- Astro Turf Trainers/Trainers (No School Shoes/No Daps)



GIRLS - Optional Items:

- Logoed Black Sports Leggings **ONLY** – (no other leggings allowed)



Recommended Items for ALL STUDENTS:

- Shin-guards for Hockey/Football
- Gum Shield for Hockey/Rugby

If a student cannot participate in a practical lesson due to injury or for medical reasons, being excused from that activity can only be considered on receipt of a signed and dated letter by parents/guardians, detailing the specific nature of the medical problem or injury. The letter must be written in full by the parent/guardian and will be kept on file.

Please note students who have notes will still be expected to bring their PE kit to the lesson, as they may be able to participate in a different way.

Students will be expected to take some part in the lesson and should be prepared for outdoor work where appropriate. In situations where a medical condition or injury prevents a student from participating for more than 2 weeks, a medical certificate from a GP, consultant or other medical professional must be provided.

Students who forget or fail to bring correct and appropriate kit will be expected to wear spare kit, to enable them to participate fully in the all aspects of the core PE programme.

It is highly recommended that every piece of PE kit is clearly named in case it is lost or left behind.
