Dear Parents and Carers

As part of this History topic learning about coal mining in our local area, we will be visiting The Radstock Museum on Wednesday 26th, Thursday 27th and Friday 28th March 2025. We will be splitting the children into 3 groups (1 for each day) and we will confirm these groups nearer the time.

We will be leaving school at 9am to talk to Radstock and then leaving the venue at 12pm and returning back to school. We are hoping that the weather will be glorious and therefore we can stop in the park for a picnic on the way back. If the weather is against us, we will eat our packed lunches on our return to school.

Your child will need:

- A packed lunch & healthy snack. If you would like the school to provide your child packed lunch, please email the office by the 19th March.
- A water bottle
- Waterproof coat
- School uniform - children can wear leggings and trainers.

For this trip, we will be asking for a voluntary contribution of £5.10 to cover the cost of entry and workshops. Please pay and consent to your child participating in the trip via ParentPay by Wednesday 12th March.

As you will be aware school finances across the country are an issue; therefore, if we do not receive a 95% total fee we unfortunately will not be able to allow the trip to go ahead.

If we do not reach the 95% target we will ask families, if they wish, to make a donation to 'top up' funds. Please do not feel pressure to do this, only do it if you can; we have had many families ask if they can be given this choice before a trip is cancelled.
