The other four days of AM tutor allow students to practise their Maths, focus on their reading and promote fundamental British Values as part of developing well-rounded and upstanding citizens. The PM tutor slot focuses on reflection, enabling students to recognise and record the positives and negatives in their day, and sharing their thoughts and concerns with their tutor.
