This term, our theme is "Here, There and Everywhere!" We have been learning about different modes of transport and look forward to exploring travel too.



In maths, the children have been matching numerals, parking numbered cars into their corresponding spaces, and exploring repeating patterns using toy cars and trains. We have used basic charts to sort, count and record how many different types of transport we have found. Also we have used shapes to copy templates of transport pictures.

In the writing area, the children have enjoyed mark-making on large sheets of paper by moving cars and trucks with pens attached to them!
