Other classes have used different media to create their own versions of the people in the picture.

We have started to talk to our preschool children about the NSPCC PANTS rule. This is an important aspect of our 'Healthy Me' theme and links to our PSHE scheme of work. It has been devised by the NSPCC to help children understand that their body belongs to them, and they should tell a safe adult (one that they trust) if anything makes them feel upset or worried.
