




Next Steps Nursery Prospectus

Welcome to Next Steps Nursery!

Our nursery is a place where all children and their families are listened to, valued and respected.

We provide a safe and secure environment where children can follow their own interests, developing a love of learning through their play. Our nursery is an exciting place for children where they are loved and cared for and offered a variety of real life experiences.

Next Steps Nursery is situated in the grounds of St John's Primary School. The purpose built nursery building is light and airy, with views of the school field and backs on to our woodland area.



The nursery has its own secure outside play area that the children access daily. There are three rooms with exciting activities for children to choose from, we operate a free flow environment and there is opportunity for all children to access both indoor and outdoor play and a large range of appropriate toys and equipment.

Being located directly behind the school's reception classes allows for a smooth transition in the summer term. The children moving on to St John's Primary School have many opportunities in the final term to learn and play with our reception children and staff.







Next Steps Nursery is open for 2 - 5 year olds and plays an integral part in the early years foundation stage, which leads seamlessly into your child's Reception year and beyond into Key Stage One.

The children follow a carefully planned, creative and child-centered approach to education. The emphasis is on learning through play and the children have access to a wide variety of equipment and resources both inside and out.







<u>Key worker</u>

At Next Steps Nursery each child and family will be allocated a 'key person' to ensure that every child's learning and care is tailored to their individual needs.

The key person will engage and support parents/guardians in guiding their child's development both at nursery and in the home. An online journal will accompany the child throughout nursery and will document each child's experiences during their time with us. This will also become a valuable keepsake of the child's early years to cherish for years to come.

Fee Structure

Next Steps Nursery is open all year round. However, the nursery will be closed at Easter, Christmas, two weeks in August, the bank holidays and two staff training days. A list with all of each year's closures will be provided.



Funding

Next Steps accepts government funding for two year olds, universal and extended funding for three to four year olds.

All 3 to 4-year-olds in England can claim up to 570 free hours per year. This is calculated as 12 hours a week for 47.5 weeks a year. The funded hours start the term after your child turns three.

You may also be eligible to receive 30-hour funding if you meet the eligibility criteria. This is calculated as 24 hours a week for 47.5 weeks a year. Information relating to funding, including the 30 hour code and details of how the funding may be split with other settings must be provided to the nursery at the start of each term for the duration of that term.

It is the responsibility of the parent/carer to check eligibility, to ensure codes are renewed and to provide information to the nursery as soon as possible.
