- Phonics continues to be of huge importance to help the children grow as both readers and writers. We will continue to work on our Phase 5. Your child may bring home flash-cards of these new sounds as we learn them so please practise reading these and applying them to your child's spelling.
- This term, Hedgehog PE sessions will be on Wednesday (Ms Rochester) and Thursday (Mrs Richardson) afternoons: a separate letter re The Dance Umbrella which the children will be working towards, will be sent later in the term. PE kits should be worn into school on PE days.
- Children do not need to bring pencil cases, stationery or bags (other than book bags) into school.
- Please send your child with their own healthy snack for morning break and a freshly filled water bottle. This fruit should be fresh fruit or vegetables as we are seeing an increase in packaged fruit snacks.
