This week at Nursery . . .



This week we have been looking at caterpillars and talking about how they turn into butterflies.

We've used the 'Hungry Caterpillar' story to explain this to the children and to bring the story to life. The children have enjoyed talking about what the caterpillar ate, and could recall when he became a big caterpillar!

Following on from this, the children have looked at some butterfly symmetry patterns. Using shapes, children matched each side of the butterflies to make them the same. They enjoyed finding the same colours and talking about the different shapes.







The children have also been doing some caterpillar size ordering, talking about the different sizes, and identifying which would come next. The children made some brilliant comparisons to work out the order, and practised some tricky cutting skills to cut around the caterpillars.

Outside, the children have enjoyed collecting resources to make a tree. They positioned the items to make branches, leaves and fruit.

When using the construction blocks, the children were particularly keen to make a fish tank enclosure. They stacked blocks horizontally and vertically to build and balance. When it began to rain the children, with some help from the adults, moved the blocks and positioned them into a house and made a roof to keep dry!
